ALAMEDA COUNTY AMATEUR WINE COMPETITION June 14th: The Good Brewer will once again be a drop off point for the Alameda County Fair's AMATEUR Wine Competition. We will begin to take wine deliveries during the first week in June. The entry fee is \$5.00 per wine. All fees AND forms must be submitted by Saturday May 12th. You may drop fees and forms at The Good Brewer or mail them directly to: Alameda County Fair, Competitive Exhibit Office, 4501 Pleasanton Ave, Pleasanton CA 94566.

Forms are available at the shop or on-line at: www.goodbrewer.com. The deadline for dropping wines at the shop is June 8th. Each entry is to be bottled in two 750 ml bottles. All entries are automatically entered into the label contest and must include the winemaker's name, varietal, division and class.

CALLING ALL BELGIAN BEER FANS!!

The Good Brewer now has a variety of imported Belgian grains. WE now have Aromatic Malt, Biscuit, Special B, Biscuit, CaraMunich and Carastan (a Belgian style crystal malt). So if you are ready to make an all Belgian brew we can take care of you.

We also have Weyermann Pilsner Malt and we have begun to carry Marris Otter. In past our English Pale Malt was a more generic malt, but we made the decision to upgrade to Marris Otter for our English Pale Malt. We hope you enjoy the change.

WINE GRAPE PRE-ORDERS

Beginning in June we will begin to take pre-orders for wine grapes. Currently we will have the following varietals available at harvest: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Petite Syrah. We may be able to land our hands on some grenache and mouvedre. If you have another varietal you would like to get give us a call and we will see what we can do. all preorders must put down a \$0.50/lb deposit.

The Beer of the Month is Rhinegarten Kolsch. This beer uses a proprietary yeast blend as used in Cologne Germany; the home of the Kolsch style. This beer is light and floral with a slight hint of fruit flavor at the finish. The is an awesome BBQ brew. This beer kit retails for \$34.00.



8 oz. Wheat Malt
1 lb. Vienna Malt
1 oz. Spalt Hops
2565 Kolsch Yeast

4 oz. Cara-Pills
2 oz Hallertauer Hops
7 lb. Light Malt Extract LME

Our Wine of the Month is the Columbia Valley Riesling.
